

Faculty position in actuarial science École d'actuariat (Actuarial science school)

Job description

The successful candidate will:

- Teach Actuarial Science courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
- Supervise undergraduate and graduate students.
- Conduct research activities in Actuarial Science susceptible of receiving support from granting agencies.
- Take part in the School's academic and administrative duties.
- Contribute to the School's national and international visibility and influence.
- Contribute to organize and maintain continuing education activities.

Selection Criteria

- Hold, or be near to obtain, a Ph.D. in Actuarial Science or a closely related discipline. Candidates meeting all of the following criteria will be granted a Ph.D. equivalence :
 - a) hold a Master's degree with thesis (or equivalent university diploma) in Actuarial Science or a closely related discipline;
 - b) be a Fellow, or equivalent, of a recognized actuarial association and have at least five years of professional experience;
 - c) demonstrate, with supporting evidence, having contributed original work and publications furthering knowledge in Actuarial Science or a closely related discipline.
- Priority will be given to candidates specialized in one of the following fields: Financial Risk, Enterprise Risk Management, Social Security, Property and Casualty Insurance.
- Demonstrate potential or experience in teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
- Demonstrate experience or excellent potential in research.
- Demonstrate experience and ability to supervise undergraduate and graduate students.
- Demonstrate ability to contribute to the School's visibility and influence, and to continuing education activities.
- Preferably, to be (or be near to be) a member of a recognized actuarial association.

- Be able to communicate and teach in French. Non-francophone applicants will be expected to follow French language classes and the competence level in French of a faculty member will be tested by the l'École de langues de l'Université Laval (ÉLUL). A successful test is required for promotion at the tenure level (professeur agrégé).
